

5.1 - How to distinguish the different Perforators Used?

Different types of Perforation

Harrow Perforation

Whole sheet is perforated in one operation by punches arranged crosswise in a honeycomb fashion.

Comb Perforation

In this type of perforation, stamps are punched on three sides at a time in a row and as a result of this arrangement the corner of the stamps are regular most of the IVth Def. were perforated with this type.
