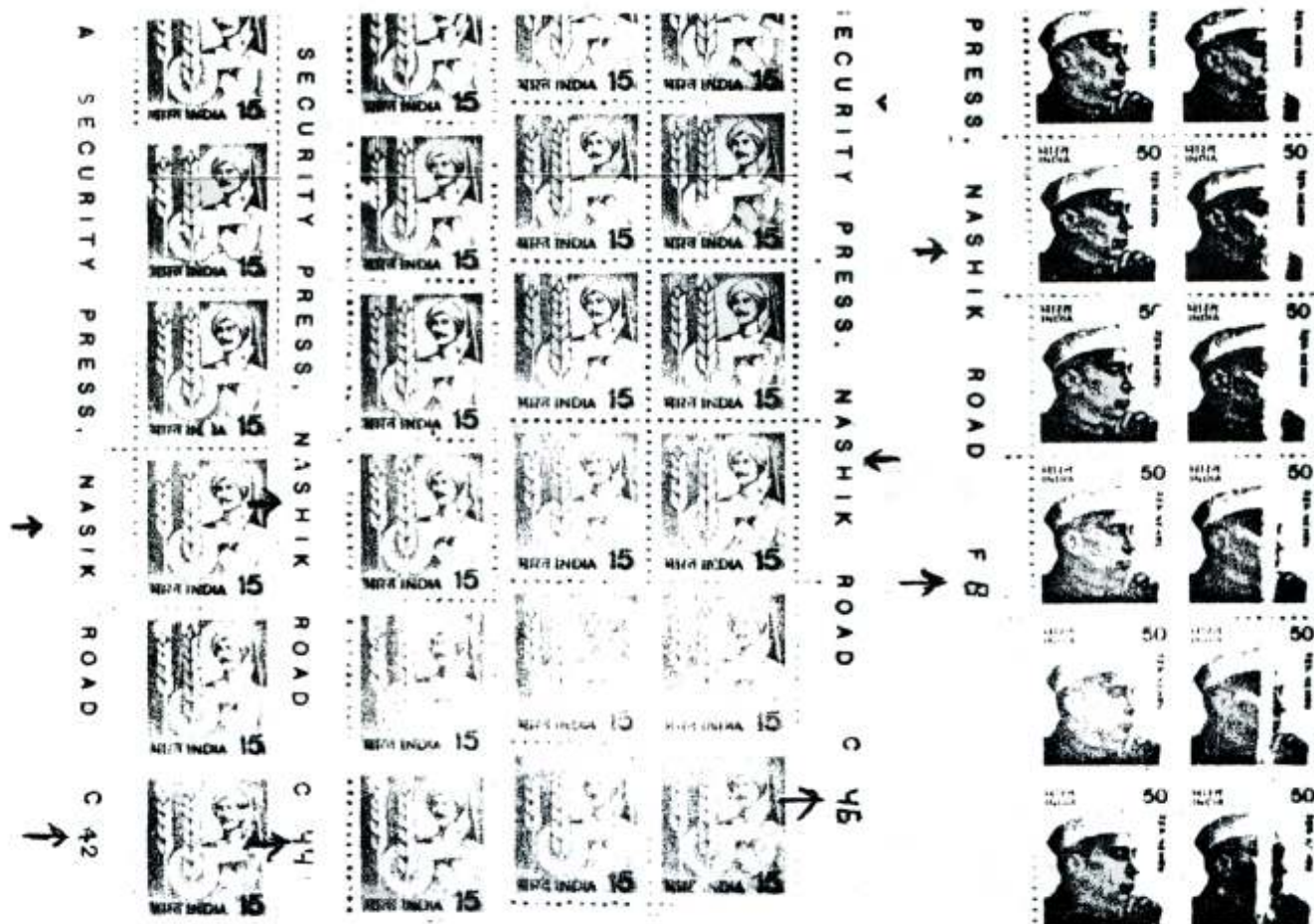

Recently the spelling of NASIK has been changed to NASHIK, which has been adopted by the India Security Press at Nasik. So a change to that effect has also been made on the marginal inscription that appears on the sheets of the definitive stamps (see illustrations). One additional point to be noticed is that, ever since they have changed the spelling, they have started using DIGITAL cylinder numbers.
